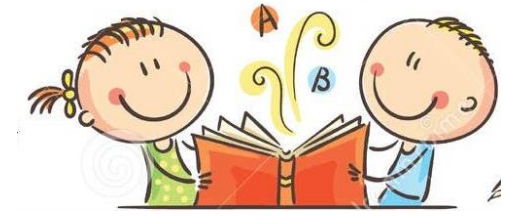

Our Topics



History

We will be exploring The Stone Age, Bronze Age, Iron Age and will be looking at local history.

Geography

We will be learning about climate and weather changes, different coasts and the world we live in.

Art

This year we will explore the work of William Morris and discover famous buildings.

Design & Technology

We will explore storybooks, become British inventors and create light-up signs.

Music

We will explore pulse, rhythm and pitch, while singing and playing instruments.

Science

We will be learning about rocks, soils, fossils, light and the effects of food on our bodies.

Computing

We will be planning and learning how to create an algorithm for an animated scene in the form of a storyboard.

RE

Throughout the year we will be learning about Christianity and Islam. We will be exploring a range of festivals.

PSHE

We will be learning about to achieve goals and how to celebrate differences.
