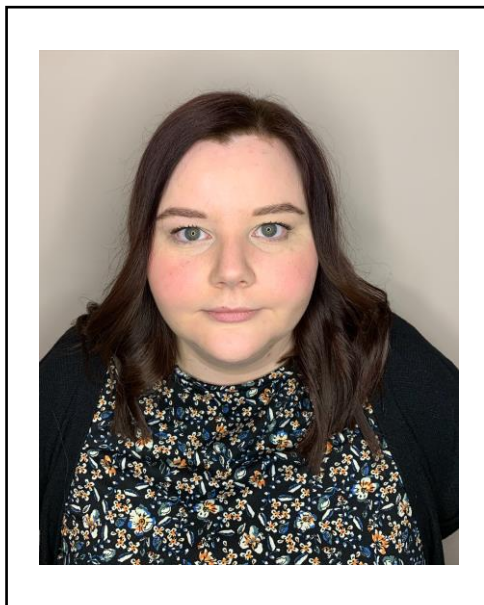

Our Topics



History

Children will be studying Ancient Egypt, The Roman Empire and a topic on Crime and Punishment, where the children will study how crime and punishment has changed over time.

Geography

We will travel along Route 66 visiting places along the way. We will also learn about how the water cycle works and will develop our knowledge about earthquakes and volcanoes.

Art

The children will be exploring plant art, where the children will produce their own still life art. They will also be studying the artist Sonia Delaunay and will take part in a topic based on recycled art.

Design & Technology

We will have the opportunity to make Christmas stockings, mini-greenhouses and learn about seasonal food, whilst trying their hand in the kitchen.

Music

We will be learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with the well-known song: Mamma Mia. Also we will listen to more ABBA hits.

Science

We will be taking part in investigations about sound, we will be building a range of electrical circuits and will be studying a range of animals in their natural environments.

Computing

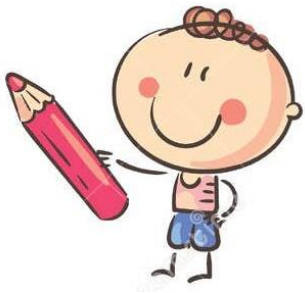
We will use laptops to create software and music. We will also become bloggers, artists and meteorologists. Also we will learn core skills that we can then apply throughout the curriculum.

RE

We will be focusing on the gospels and will be thinking about the type of world Jesus wanted. We will explore the Trinity and will look at core stories from the bible. We will also look at the Sikh faith.

PSHE

Children will be taking part in various topics that will help prepare them for changes that may happen in the future.



Assessments



- In Year 4, the children will be completing the Multiplication Times Tables Check. It is a statutory multiplication check and will take place at the end of the year in June.
- This assessment will test their times tables up to 12×12 . Children will have 6 seconds to answer each question on an iPad.
- Throughout the year we will prepare your child for the assessment in school. Please practice the rapid recall of times tables with your child at home.



Reading



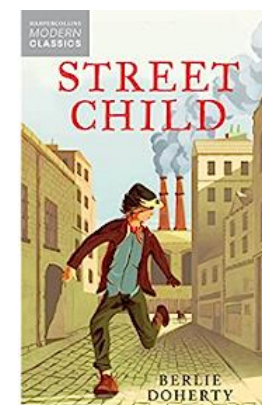
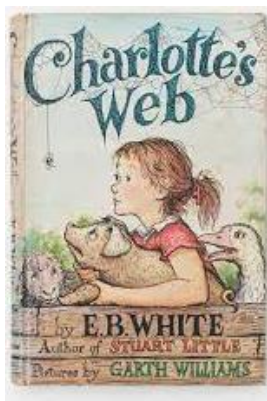
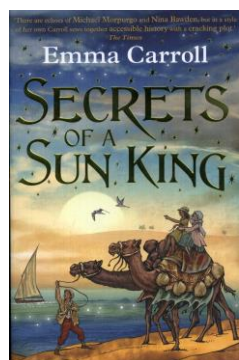
In reading lessons, the children will be studying the following texts throughout the year. The texts will be linked to their various topics.

Reading



- Your child will be given a reading diary which will include common exception words to learn. Your child will practice reading and spelling these words weekly.
- Your child will be given an AR book which is suitable for their reading ability.
- Your child will read with an adult in school, please support your child's reading by listening to them at home and recording in their diary.



Homework



Each child will be provided with an English and Maths learning journal. These will go home every Friday. We kindly ask that work is completed and journals are back in school by the following Wednesday.

Your child will be asked to complete:

- Spellings (common exception words)
- One piece of English- This may be a SPaG focus or reading comprehension
- One piece of Maths work
- Occasionally, there may be an extra piece relating to one of the foundation subjects.
