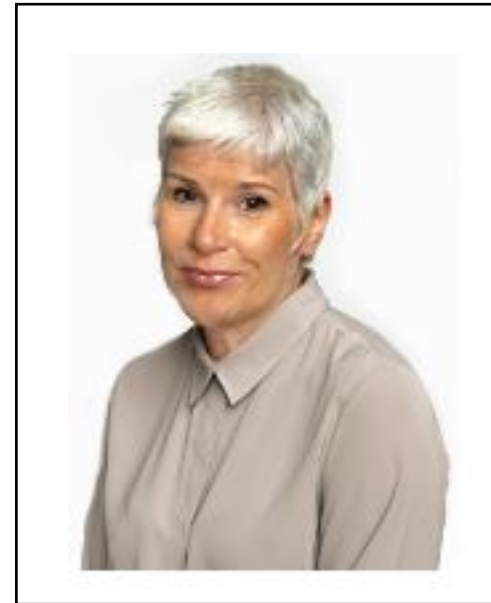

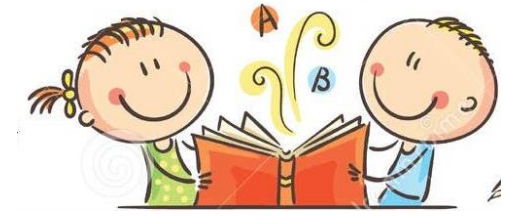

Reading



- Your child will be given a reading diary which will include common exception words to learn. Your child will practice reading and spelling these words weekly.
- Your child will be given an AR book which is suitable for their reading ability.
- Your child will read with an adult in school, please support your child's reading by listening to them at home and recording in their diary.



Homework



Each child will be provided with an English and Maths learning journal. These will go home every Friday. We kindly ask that work is completed and journals are back in school by the following Wednesday.

Your child will be asked to complete:

- Spellings (common exception words)
- One piece of English- This may be a SPaG focus or reading comprehension
- One piece of Maths work
- Occasionally, there may be an extra piece relating to one of the foundation subjects.
