ENGLISH

Year 3 will be reading a variety of texts including fiction and non-fiction. We will be starting the half term with The Iron Man. Our focus will be developing reading accuracy and understanding.

In writing, our focus is to improve grammatical features and sentence structures through various styles of writing. Year 3 will complete a poem, recount and a narrative.

RE

Our big question for this half term is 'What is it like to follow God?' Children will be making clear links between the story of Noah and the idea of covenant, promises that Christians make at a wedding ceremony and finally, how we live in school and the wider world.

HISTORY

In history this half term, the children will explore the key features of the Bronze and Iron Ages and answer our key question 'Which was more impressive?' The children will use a variety of sources of evidence to investigate the period, including archaeological evidence with a focus on the Amesbury Archer, the Lindow Man, Roman written accounts of the Celts and reconstruction drawings of both periods.

PSHE

Dreams and Goals will be our focus for this half term. We will begin the new year by identifying our dreams and ambitions. We will discuss how to remain positive, focused and motivated through any obstacle that may occur.

ART

SCIENCE

MATHS

This will move onto measurements and calculating the length and perimeter of shapes. Finally, Year 3 will solve word problems involving all four operations.
