

Reading



- Children will bring home a reading book that is suitable based on their current phonetic ability.
- Please listen to your child read at home, even if it is for just five minutes, and record it in their reading record.
- Children will get opportunities to read to an adult in school every week.
- Children will have the opportunity to borrow a book from the library to enjoy reading at home with you.



Phonics



- Children will continue to have daily RWI lessons.
- Children are grouped in lessons according to the sounds they already know.
- At the end of Year 1, children will complete the **statutory phonics screening check**. This tests their ability to decode words using the sounds that they have learnt.
- This test will be administered by Miss Brookbanks.
- We will be continuing with the RWI parent workshops throughout the year. I hope you will join us!



Trackit Lights – Behaviour It's Good to be Green



- Our new behaviour system has been introduced to reward children for making positive choices
- Children will earn Golden Time throughout the week.
- Children will also earn prizes at the end of ech term based on their behaviour score.
- Each day will end with Reflection Time we discuss the day (restorative practice)
- Pupils will receive warnings and warning lights (if necessary) to encourage them to make positive choices





Homework



Each child will be provided with a homework login card.

Homework will be set online **every Friday.** We kindly ask that work is completed by the following Wednesday.

Your child will be asked to complete:

- Spelling practice (linked to the curriculum for this year group) this will be set on Spelling Shed.
- Occasionally, there may be an extra piece relating to one of the foundation subjects.
- Watch out as there may be something for you as well parents!

As the year progresses, we will start for Maths, TT practise – this will link to the taught tables (and give opportunities to review previously taught table facts) - this will be set on TT Rockstars
