Our Topics



History

Children will be studying

Ancient Egypt, The Roman

Empire and a topic on

Crime and Punishment,

where the children will

study how crime and

punishment has changed

over time.

Geography

We will travel along Route
66 visiting places along the
way. We will also learn
about how the water cycle
works and will develop our
knowledge about
earthquakes and volcanoes.

Art

The children will be exploring plant art, where the children will produce their own still life art. They will also be studying the artist Sonia Delaunay and will take part in a topic based on recycled art.

Design & Technology

We will have the opportunity to make Christmas stockings, minigreenhouses and learn about seasonal food, whilst trying their hand in the kitchen.

Music

We will be learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with the well-known song: Mamma Mia.

We will listen to more ABBA hits.

Science

We will be taking part in investigations about sound, we will be building a range of electrical circuits and will be studying a range of animals in their natural environments.

Computing

We will use laptops to create software and music.
We will also become bloggers, artists and meteorologists. We will also learn core skills that we can then apply throughout the curriculum.

RE

We will be focusing on the gospels and will be thinking about the type of world Jesus wanted.

We will explore the Trinity and will look at core stories from the Bible. We will also learn about Sikhi.

PSHE

Children will be taking part in various topics that will help prepare them for changes that may happen in the future: Celebrating difference, Dreams and Goals, Healthy Me, Relationships and Changing Me.



Assessments



- In Year 4, the children will be completing the Multiplication Times Tables Check. It is a statutory multiplication check and will take place at the end of the year in June.
- This assessment will test their times tables up to 12 x 12. Children will have 6 seconds to answer each question on an iPad.
- Throughout the year we will prepare your child for the assessment in school. Please practice the rapid recall of times tables with your child at home.



Reading



- Your child will be given a reading diary which will include common exception words to learn. Your child will practice reading and spelling these words in school.
- Your child will be given an AR book which is suitable for their reading ability.
- Your child will read with an adult in school, please support your child's reading by listening to them at home and recording in their diary.



Trackit Lights – Behaviour It's Good to be Green



- Our new behaviour system has been introduced to reward children for making positive choices
- Children will earn Golden Time throughout the week.
- Children will also earn prizes at the end of ech term based on their behaviour score.
- Each day will end with Reflection Time we discuss the day (restorative practice)
- Pupils will receive warnings and warning lights (if necessary) to encourage them to make positive choices

Homework



Each child will be provided with a homework login card.

- Maths TT practise this will link to the taught tables (and give opportunities to review previously taught table facts) this will be set on TT Rockstars
- Occasionally, there may be an extra piece relating to one of the foundation subjects.
