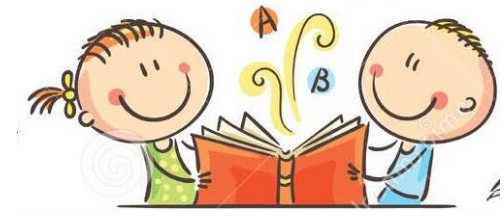

Reminders

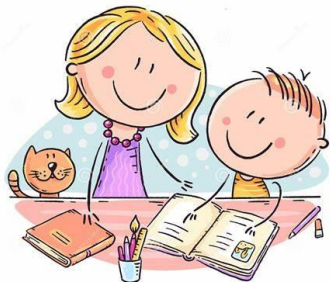


Gates are open from **8:30**. They will be staffed from **8:40 - 8:55am** in the morning. A member of staff will always be available to speak to every day.
