ENGLISH

RE

We will venture out of school on our walk of the local area and gather information about what we can see on our way before returning to class to create a 3D map of Bradley.

The next jigsaw piece in our Jigsaw journey is all about 'Celebrating Differences'. We will think about how similar and different we are to each other. We will also talk about what bullying is and how we can celebrate the differences between us all.

MATHS

COMPUTING
