ENGLISH

During Autumn 2, the children will be moving away from the narrative text 'Mr Nobody's Eyes' as we move into a non-narrative focus this half term. The children will be reading the poem 'The Highwayman' by Alfred Noyes, exploring the characters, formal vs informal speech and concluding our topic with writing a debate based on the text.

We will continue to work on the children's grammar and punctuation skills in specific GPS focus lessons once a week.

RE

Creation and Science

In Autumn 2, children will be learning about creation and science. We will address what Bible texts say about God and human nature and begin to think about the purpose of the Genesis Creation text (and Psalm 8). Pupils may ask whether the Genesis account is 'true', reflecting a common view that religious accounts of the universe's origins are in conflict with scientific accounts.

Geography

South America: The Amazon

In Geography, Year 6 will be learning about the Amazon region of South America, considering what it is like to live in the region as well as how it is being damaged and how it can be protected.



PSHE

Understanding Differences

In PSHE, we will be learning about what makes us unique, where differences can cause power struggles and focussing on celebrating our differences.



Art

Landscape Art

In art lessons, children will be learning about how to create landscape art using a range of skills including the use of perspective, collage, abstract, atmosphere and watercolour. We will take inspiration from different artists to create our final piece at the end of the term

MATHS

As Year 6 progress through Autumn 2, they will begin to focus on applying their arithmetic knowledge to a range of problem-solving activities. They will develop their testing skills and discuss approaches to worded problems involving all four operations as well as shape, measure and data.

Through reasoning, children will express their understanding in different contexts to ensure they have a deeper understanding of the range of skills that they will need to apply during their SATS.

We are Computational Thinkers
