ENGLISH

During the build up to SATs, Year 6 will be developing their knowledge and understanding of spelling, grammar and punctuation in preparation for their upcoming examinations.

We will also be reading a range of fiction and nonfiction texts and will be focusing on the areas of retrieval, inference and understanding authorial intent.

Following the completion of SATs tests, we will continue to develop children's skills in writing. We will focus on a range of fiction and non-fiction genres inspired by narratives and video snippets, including the book Letters from the Lighthouse.

Children will make connections between the belief in the

Kingdom of God and how Christians put their beliefs into

practice. We will relate Christian teachings and beliefs about

God's Kingdom to the issues, problems and opportunities of

our own lives and the life of our own community in the world

today, offering insights about whether or not the world could

or should learn from Christian ideas.

PSHE

Relationships

We will be learning about healthy relationships. We will discuss how to take care of mental health, the stages of grief and different types of loss, how to recognise when people are trying to gain power or control, ways to judge whether something online is safe and helpful and how to use technology to communicate positively with others.

ART

Express Yourself

Children will explore their identity through observing facial expressions, clothing, emotions linked to colour and will understand how body language can convey emotion. They will express themselves through a range of different media and cartoon artwork. They will focus on how choice of lines and font can portray emotion or activity. The children will also be creating a sculpture.

MATHS

In the run up to SATS, we will continue to work on arithmetic skills and how to apply those skills to reasoning problems. Each morning your child will be learning in their maths groups and revising in their maths groups some afternoons. Children are being encouraged to revise at home using their CGP revision guides.

After the completion of SATs, we will continue to embed children's knowledge and understanding of the Maths curriculum in preparation for their transition to secondary education. We will complete a range of projects to develop children's understanding of the use of Maths in day-to-day life.

COMPUTING
