

2nd June

This week we will read the story '**Dear Zoo**' by **Rod Campbell** and following on from this we will set up our own zoo in class, thinking about what each animal will need. We will name animals that are in a zoo and complete work around the sizes of different animals. We will be looking at the patterns on animals and recreating them with our drawings and paintings.

9th June

This week we will continue our work on '**Dear Zoo**' by working together to make props such as animal masks and boxes that will help us to retell the story. We will work on our counting skills by counting how many animals we can see. We will continue our week by drawing our favourite zoo animals. Finally, we will think about where zoo animals live in the wild and will make a big watering hole outside for them all to visit, just like they would in Africa!

16th June

We will read the book '**Off to the Park**' by **Childs Play** as the inspiration for our work. We will be discussing places that we can visit such as parks, beaches and museums. The children will share places that they have visited. We will look for the places on a map and how long it takes to get there.

23rd June

We will continue to read '**Off to the Park**' by **Childs Play**. This week we will think about how we get to different places. The children will name different kinds of transport such as bus, train and aeroplane. We will set up an aeroplane in the classroom, ready to travel wherever our imagination takes us! Each child will practise matching and recognising numbers with their own plane ticket.

30th June

This week we will read '**What the ladybird heard at the seaside**' by **Julia Donaldson** and **Lydia Monks**. The children will be putting their phonics knowledge to good use by sorting objects that begin with the same letter. They will 'Fred Talk' objects from the seaside to find out what sounds they can hear. They will use instruments to recreate noises such as waves crashing.

7th July

This week we will be continuing our work with '**What the ladybird heard at the seaside**'. We will be having a 'whacky water play day' where children will explore capacity, filling and emptying different containers. We will explore mixing coloured water and painting with it.
