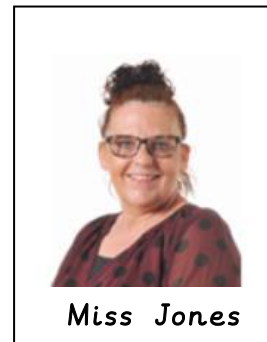
Our final topic in Reception is **Let's go!** We will be exploring different destinations and learning all about the different ways to get there. We even have our own destination planned and we will be thinking about how we will travel to and from there. Our first week back will focus on Summer, where we will revisit the four seasons of the year. We will look at what the weather is like throughout the summer months and what people like to do during them.

23rd June and 30th June

For the next two weeks, the children will learn all about holiday destinations as well as days out. The children will have chance to share stories of any holidays and days out that they have been on with their family. Children will be able to use a map to find places they have visited and think about how close or far away they are. They will then think about how they can travel to different destinations, finding out about different kinds of transport. The children will also have the chance to use various construction materials to create their own form of transport to get them to and from different destinations.

9th and 16th June

Following on from our introduction to summer, our next two weeks will be based around the story of **'The 100 Decker Bus'**. Through this story we will be thinking about places we can visit in our local area as well as places we could visit on holiday. The children will think about how we travel to places which are near as well as places which are further away. We will reflect on our visit to church and how we got there as well as think ahead to plan a very special trip we will be going on together.

This term our big question is:
"What makes every person special, unique and important?"

We will be exploring how we are all different. The children will make comparisons and find differences between our cultures, families, talents, and personalities. We will discuss how we shine our lights and celebrate the achievements of ourselves and others.

Phonics

This half term children will be solidifying Set 1 and Set 2 sounds. Every week your child will come home with the banded book they have been practising in lessons. It is important to hear your child read as often as possible to increase fluency and begin to speedy read.

Book bags should be brought in daily and reading books returned every Friday so that your child can receive a new one.

7th and 14th July

Our class text over these final two weeks will be **'You Choose Your Dream'**. This will introduce the idea of moving on to Year 1. Children will use this time to prepare for their transition day and complete a passport to Year 1, where they will tell their new teacher all about themselves.

We will be finding a very special way to celebrate the children completing their time in Early Years Foundation Stage, so keep your eyes peeled for more information.
